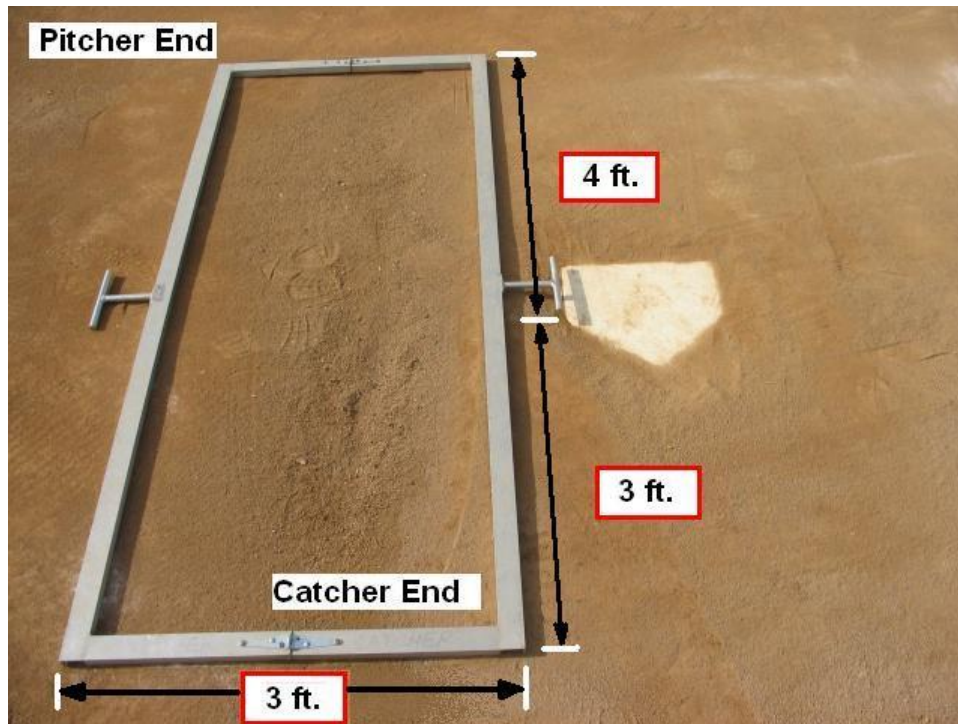


MVGS Field Preparation

Lining the Field and Using the Foldable Batter's Box Template

1. Unfold the template and align the 'T' handle over the side of home plate. Pay particular attention to the ends indicating the direction of the template. They will be marked for the 'Pitcher' end and the 'Catcher' end. Also make sure the template is aligned in a parallel direction towards 2nd base.

2. Once in place and aligned, use an object (i.e. nail from the string reel or pitcher's mound) to scribe the dirt inside the template or step lightly on it to create an impression. The preferred method is to use a scribing object as this will keep the template less prone to warping from the latter method.

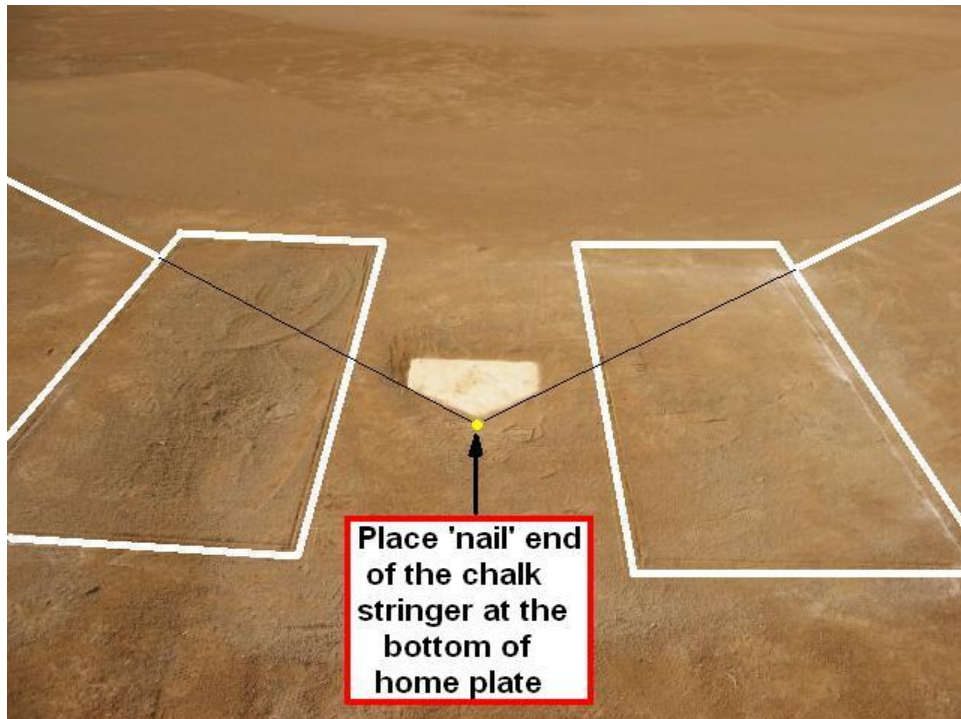

3. Once the template impressions are made, use the chalker to line the batter's box area.



4. Use the chalk stringer as a guide to align the 1st and 3rd base lines from home plate.
