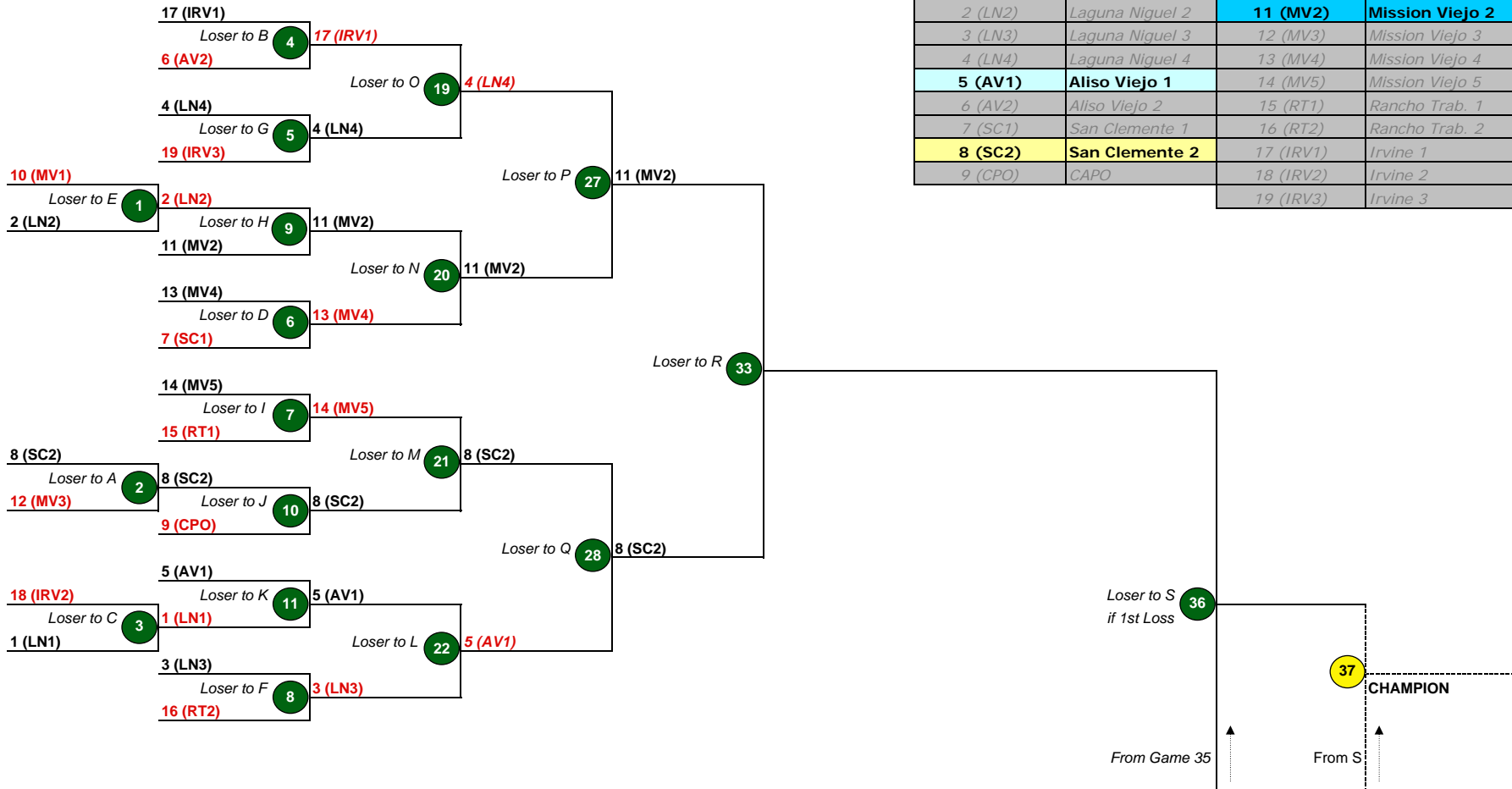


2010 14u Inter-City Tournament

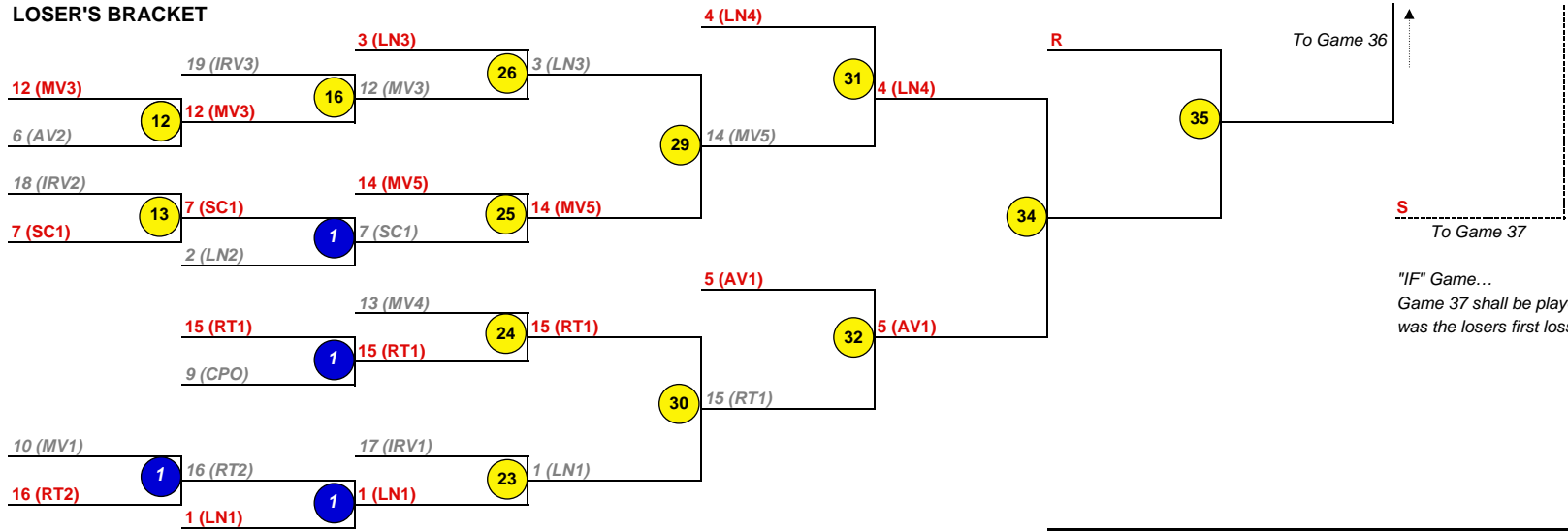
WINNER'S BRACKET

2010 14u Inter-City Tournament Rules

- 1 Team listed first (top) shall occupy 3rd base dugout. Coin toss to determine the "Home" team.
- 2 Home field ground rules, fair and foul, dead ball areas, and specific safety issues will be followed.
- 3 Round robin batting.
- 4 No new inning after 1:25, finish the inning. The game must produce a winner.
- 5 6 runs max for the first four (4) innings. Unlimited from the fifth inning on.
- 6 No player rotation required; unlimited pitching.
- 7 Courtesy runners (CR) for pitchers and catchers. The CR shall be the last out. Should no out be on the books yet, it shall be the batter scheduled to bat last in the inning.
- 8 Injured offensive players: You may use a CR for an injured player one time. The runner will be the last recorded out. After that, the player can be removed from the game without penalty.
- 9 Mercy: 15 after 3, 12 after 4, 8 after 5
- 10 Two umpires system: Each team shall pay an umpire \$35.00.
- 11 One minute or 5 pitches between innings.
- 12 A player arriving late can be added to the bottom of the batting order.
- 13 A player leaving early must check out with both score keepers, with no penalty.
- 14 Should a player not check out with the scorekeepers and a batting out of order occurs, ASA rules shall govern.
- 15 Only players that are rostered for each particular team may play.
- 16 Tie Breaker Rule: Should the game require a tie breaker; the player scheduled to bat last in the inning shall start the inning at 2nd base. No courtesy runners (CR) will be allowed.
- 17 One (1) substitution player is allowed only if a team can not produce 9 rostered players to start a game. The substitute player must play outfield and bat last. The substitute player must be an age appropriate player registered with the league she is substituting for.
- 18 Niguel Hills Middle School (LNGS) fields are on a shared facility with a school, which has a 'no dogs' policy from the city. No dogs at this facility please. Violators shall be ejected by the umpire.
